




Proposed New Delineation










Parliamentary Constituencies




Online Electoral Maps



Map Navigation Guide 01




Use a mouse with a wheel. Use the wheel to zoom the map in and out.



Map Navigation Guide 02

Popup details - Deselect the shaded SPR layers. Then shift & zoom the map to the location that you wish to explore.

Select the layers you wish to explore. Click on the specific location that you are exploring. A details box will pop up.



To study another part of the map, simply click on that part of the map. A new popup box will appear. Use these maps to understand the current delimitation in your area and how it can be improved.

DUN N29 Seri Serdang – 72,845 electors

Vote Value Ratio almost 1:5

PAR P092 Sabak Bernam – 37,390 electors


PAR P109 Kapar — 144,369 electors

Vote Value Ratio almost 1:4

Less than 20% of the popular vote is needed to win the **112 smallest** Parliamentary Constituencies and thereby control Parliament!



Erosion of Constitutional Contol





The Spirit of the Constitution remains

13th Schedule, Clause 2 (c)

(c) the number of electors within each constituency in a State ought to be approximately equal except that, having regard to the greater difficulty of reaching electors in the country districts and the other disadvantages facing rural constituencies, a measure of weightage for area ought to be given to such constituencies;

This point must be driven home in challenging the SPR delineation




SPR Redelineation Expected

- Previous Redelineation was in 2003
- SPR Chairman announced intention in 2013
- Sarawak Redelineation was done in 2015
- Sabah Polling Districts have been revised
- Peninsula Polling Districts also revised recently
- Can expect Redelineation before GE14
- Stakeholders must prepare for this



Polling District Boundary Gerrymandering






Who Decides on Polling Districts?

- According to the law, the EC decides.
- The electors have no part in the decision.
- If the electors are not satisfied, can they object?
- During redelineation process, Polling District maps are not released so electors can't identify issues.
- Electors are expected to object based on the EC proposed DUN and Parlimen boundaries.



Sarawak Redelineation






Are the people truly able to object?

- The right to object implies the right to access the required information.
- If the required information is not available, it is a sham to claim that the people can object.
- For meaningful citizen participation, maps of the new Polling Districts must be released.
- Electors should also be able to find out in which Polling District they have been placed, for which the Electoral Roll must be made easily available.



Simplified Redelineation Process



Comprehensive Delimitation Process In Accordance with Federal Constitution Thirteenth Schedule Part 1, Section 2



EC publish NOTICE in a Gazette and a newspaper regarding the impact of the proposed boundaries and display venues





Thirteenth Schedule - Objections

- 5. Where, on the publication of the notice under section 4 of a proposed recommendation of the Election Commission for the alteration of any constituencies, the Commission receive any representation objecting to the proposed recommendations from—
 - (a) the State Government or any local authority whose area is wholly or partly comprised in the constituencies affected by the recommendation; or
 - (b) a body of one hundred or more persons whose names are shown on the current electoral rolls of the constituencies in question,

the Commission shall cause a local enquiry to be held in respect of those constituencies.



Registration of Objectors

- Mass recruitment
 Most appropriate when recruiting from large groups. Each
 person enters the personal data and signs on the
 common form.
- Individual recruitment
 Appropriate when recruiting individuals separately. Each person signs a separate form.
- Online registration
 Best for mass recruitment of tech savvy people who register using their own mobile device or PC. The form is sent by email for Objector signature.





The importance of Objector registration

- If any Constituency cannot get 100+ valid electors to sign up, they lose their right to object.
- If every Constituency can raise objections, that will send a powerful message to the EC.
- Every signature is precious. All variations of previous Objector Registration forms will be used.
- If improvement to the current forms are needed, they can be done without losing the old signatures.



Raising Objections

Two categories of objections must be raised:

- 1. Objections relating to the specific proposals made by the EC, according to their regulations;
- Objections addressing other defects & deficiencies in the current delineation & the process itself. These need to be put on record.




TM Proposed Redelineation


Who will write Objection Report?

- This is a very technical task.
- There are several specialist groups doing this.
- They will train the regional groups in organising the data and writing the report.
- It is best that objections are coordinated Statewide.
- Every state must appoint a State Coordinator.



Regional Teams

Coordinators are needed at each level





What should regional teams do?

- 1. Meet up and arrange coordination at the local level.
- 2. Recruit and register enough objectors.
- 3. The local coordinator must prepare to collect and organise signed objector forms.
- 4. Compile data on current electoral defects.
- 5. When EC releases the Syor-Syor, obtain copies and study the proposals.



What should regional teams do?

- 6. Study the proposals & identify issues.
- 7. Compile report following given templates
- 8. Identify 3 representative Objectors for each Constituency.
- 9. Prepare Objection Forms and signatory attachments.
- 10.Submit to EC and obtain documentary evidence of submission.
